Definitions:

¹ "Number of Students Who Began Program" is the number of students who began the program who were scheduled to complete the program within the reporting calendar year.

² "Number of Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began program minus the number of "Students Unavailable for Graduation," which means those students who have died, been incarcerated, or have been called to active military duty.

³ "Number of Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length.

⁴ "Completion Rate" is the number of "Graduates" divided by the "Number of Student Available for Graduation."

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⁵“150% Graduates” is the number of students who completed within 101-150% of the program length.

⁶“150% Completion Rate” is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 101-150% of the published program length divided by the “Number of Students Available for Graduation” in the published program length period.

⁷ “Number of Graduates Available for Employment” means the “Number of Graduates” minus the “Number of Graduates Unavailable for Employment,” which means those graduates, who after graduation, have died, been incarcerated, have been called to active military duty, are international students that left the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.

⁸“Number of Graduates Employed in the Field” means graduates who report they are gainfully employed within 6 months of graduation in a position for which the skills obtained through the education and training provided by the institution are required or provided a significant advantage to the graduate in obtaining the position.

⁹“Placement Rate of Employed in the Fields %” is calculated by divided the “Number of Graduates Employed in the Field” by the “Number of Graduates Available for Employment.”

¹⁰“Number of Students Taking Exam” is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of published program length and for whom the first reported exam is the first exam that was available after their completion of the program.

¹¹“Exam Date” is the date for the first available exam after the student completed the program.

¹²“Passage Rate” is calculated by dividing “Number of Students who Passed the Exam” by the “Number of Graduates” who took the reported licensing exam.

¹³“Number Who Passed First Exam Taken” is the “Number of Students” who took and passed the licensing exam in the reported calendar year on the first attempt.

¹⁴ Salary is reported by the student. Not all graduates have reported their salary.
